Re: COVID Report

The week of July 11 through July 17 resulted in a significant increase in the number of new COVID cases in Wayne County. Two hundred thirty-five new cases occurred compared to 154 the week before. This represents a 53% increase in new COVID cases.

While the country is experiencing a dramatic increase in COVID cases caused by the Delta variant, Wayne County has not experienced a Delta variant case since June 12, 2021. A total of nine Delta variant cases have been recorded in Wayne County. The other variant cases have been the U.K. variant.

Although there has been an increase in new COVID cases the positivity rate remains low. COVID positivity rate for the city of Detroit is 2.2% and for the rest of Wayne County 1.9%.

The safety protocols throughout the Court will remain in place for the near future. Based significantly on the vaccination rate for Wayne County and the City of Detroit. The vaccination rates are as follows:

<i>Wayne County (except Detroit)</i>	<i>65% of those 12 years of age and older have received one dose of the COVID vaccine. 59% of those 12 years of age and older are fully vaccinated.</i>
<i>City of Detroit</i>	<i>39% of those 12 years of age and older have received one dose of the COVID vaccine. 32% of those 12 years of age and older are fully vaccinated</i>

The Court will continue to take safeguards to protect the health and safety of staff, judges and all members of the public who visit our Court facilities. Additional data will be supplied as we receive it.
